- Dallas ISD School Performance rating is "Competing"
- 192 seniors are pledging to take the Dallas County Promise – fulfilling the "promise" gives them free tuition for two years at the University of North Texas
- New student group at North Dallas – Ladies of Leadership. Ten girls are in the initial program that pairs each young lady with a female mentor. The program is in conjunction with Church of the Incarnation
